Girls' Uniform

Smart, black, suit style tailored jacket or blazer. No leather or denim jackets.	No logo required.
Black Skirt.	Plain and of appropriate length i.e. not more than 7cms above the knee. Plain black tights
Black classic trousers. No black jeans.	Classic tailored trousers. No flares, leggings, jeans etc. No decorative belts.
White reverse collar blouse* or white blouse with standard collar. White blouse with standard collar optional for September 2016 - July 2017 then compulsory from September 2017.	i.e. plain, traditional style with collar, not low cut or patterned.
Tie: Sixth Form Tie (optional for September 2016 – July 2017 then compulsory from September 2017. We encourage Year 12 students to purchase the new shirt and tie for September 2016).	Sixth Form tie may be purchased from school.
Black V-neck sweater or cardigan (optional).	Plain knit, long sleeved; no cardigans, fashion tops etc.
Black Shoes (no logo).	No boots or sandals.
Top Coat.	Plain, dark colours; no hoodies/denim or leather jackets etc.
Jewellery.	One pair of discreet earrings. No nose or other facial piercings.
No extremes of hair colour.

Boys' Uniform

Smart, black, suit style tailored jacket or blazer. No leather or denim jackets.	No logo required.
Black classic trousers. No black jeans.	Classic tailored trousers. No flares, jeans etc. No decorative belts.
White shirt with collar.	Plain, traditional style.
Tie.	Sixth Form tie may be purchased from school.
Black V-neck sweater or cardigan (optional).	Plain knit, long sleeved; no cardigans, fashion tops etc.
Black Shoes (no logo).	No boots or sandals.
Top Coat.	Plain, dark colours. No hoodies/denim or leather jackets etc.
Jewellery.	No earrings; no nose or other facial piercings
No extremes of hair colour.	

Notes:

1. Skirts must be of an appropriate length i.e. not more than 7 cms above the knee.
2. Trousers must be classic, tailored trousers – no other styles acceptable.
3. Any headwear worn for religious reasons should be of a plain, dark coloured material.
4. All items marked* are only available from approved suppliers.

The final decision on the appropriateness of dress, hair and jewellery rests with the Headteacher; adhering to these guidelines is a condition of membership of the Sixth Form.
