Re: Natural History Museum, London

On **Tuesday 22nd January 2019**, the Geography Department would like to offer up to 60 students the chance to visit the **Natural History Museum in London**. The focus of the visit will be to study tectonic activity, the topic that Year 9 geography students will be studying in January.

Included in the visit will be:

- An interactive science show focusing on geological interactions at tectonic plate boundaries and the methods used by scientists and geologists to study earthquakes and volcanoes.
- A visit to the Volcanoes and Earthquakes exhibition, where students will learn about the human impact of tectonic hazards.
- An opportunity to try the museum's famous 'earthquake simulator.'

Students will be given some free time in the afternoon to visit other exhibitions within the Natural History Museum or to walk to the nearby V and A museum, Science Museum or Harrods.

The trip will leave school at approximately 7.30am and return by approximately 6.30pm. Please ensure arrangements are made for your child to get home safely.


In order to make this trip viable we need to ask for a contribution of **£26.00** towards the cost of transport, cover and entrance fees. Students may choose to bring their own food or to purchase food in one of the museum's 3 cafes / restaurants. **Students are not expected to wear school uniform, but must dress appropriately.**

Should you wish your son / daughter to participate in this visit, please complete and return the attached consent form together with a cheque/cash for £26.00 These should be handed in to your child's geography teacher in a sealed envelope with your child's name clearly marked on it by **Friday November 30th**.
