# **Estyn**

It has been a busy two weeks at Caerleon Comprehensive School preparing for our important visitors on Monday. #### **Attendance Module ClassCharts**

On Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> of March we are aiming to 'go live' with the attendance module of Classcharts. This will enable you to see the attendance of your child to registration and lessons. Please be aware that you can view your child's attendance the day later, so for Monday, you will be able to view their attendance on the Tuesday (and so on). Please note that our attendance officer spends the first two hours of each day ensuring the attendance for the day before is accurate, so you can therefore expect to see your child's accurate attendance for the day before after **10am the next day**.

Please note that if your child was missing and was expected to be in school, we would always contact you on the day, so procedures and processes have not changed in this respect. For example, if your child was marked present in AM reg and period one, and did not arrive to period two, we have a process in place to look for them and then contact you immediately if they are not found.

The processes for reporting your child as absent have also not changed and it is still expected that you call the school, email the attendance officer or report the absence via the Schoolgateway app if your child is not going to be in school on any given day.

## Professional Learning Day (INSET)7th March

On the 7<sup>th</sup> March we have a professional learning day for staff so the school is closed to students. On this day, colleagues will be travelling across the region to access professional learning provided by the WJEC (exam board) about the new specifications at GCSE level for our September 2025 Y10 cohort. It is an exciting yet challenging time for secondary schools as we implement the new specifications, and we will be making the most of the day to prepare ourselves as fully as possible to teach the new specifications well.
